



The IR Quality Registry

Participation promotes better patient care.



The new national quality registry for interventional radiology, led by the Society of Interventional Radiology and the American College of Radiology, is designed to promote quality of care for patients undergoing interventional radiology procedures.

The registry will enable the collection of performance measures for image-guided interventional procedures, and participating facilities and physicians will receive reports based on aggregated benchmarks to facilitate

patient safety and quality improvement efforts. In addition, the IR registry has the potential to provide participants with additional opportunities to fulfill CMS Physician Quality Reporting System reporting requirements, and gain maintenance of certification credit from the American Board of Radiology.

How to participate using HI-IQ

Follow these steps to begin participating:

Step 1:

Register your facility in the National Radiology Data Registry (NRDR) by contacting ACR.

- Sign or update a participation agreement making sure to check IR Registry.
- Know your NRDR facility ID, login and password.

Step 2:

Contact your HI-IQ Account Manager to sign a Scope of Work adding the IR Registry to your licensed HI-IQ software. If you don't already use HI-IQ, contact us at 866-604-4447.

Step 3:

When using HI-IQ, be sure to select the new SIR Performed Procedures when entering your encounters for registry-eligible procedures. Simply complete your encounters and your data will be submitted automatically to the IR Registry.
